Friday, July 24th 2015 was the hottest days of the week celebration of the European People Festival. This day will certainly go down in history of Złocieniec and stay in the memory of all the inhabitants. "United in diversity" is the motto of the European Union. It means that to ensure peace and prosperity and protect cultures, traditions and languages in Europe, Europeans should act together. Under this motto

we held a parade through the streets of the city. Unusual, dreamlike, colourful European integration, these words can describe the prevailing atmosphere during the parade of countries taking part in this year's celebration of the festival.

At this point, we wanted to thank the club motorcycling "Free the Falcons," who on its own initiative decided to join the parade.

The official part took place at the main stage at the amphitheatre. There was a ceremony of handing over cups to winning teams involved in artistic and theatrical presentations, cooking on the boardwalk

Ireland won most of cups, and representatives of Hungary won by the highest number of points in the overall standings, but Latvians are officially hosts of the European People's Festival 2016.
